## DISTRICT SAVES POSTAGE ON REGISTRATION PACKETS

The Anthony Wayne Local School District continues to watch every dollar that it spends. One expenditure that adds up very quickly is that of postage. The district has traditionally mailed registration packets and State test results to families over the summer. While this may be convenient for families, it is costly for the school district. Last summer, the high school piloted having families pick their packets up at the school during the summer. The pilot program proved successful, so district administrators put a plan in action to have all registration materials either sent home with students at the end of the school year, or picked up at a designated location. The district will save a substantial amount of money by not mailing all of these materials. For example, the high school mailing alone would have cost approximately \$2,300 this year. While the high school packets are typically the most costly to mail throughout the district, the cost of the entire district mailing would certainly be a substantial amount of money. District administrators would like to thank everyone for their cooperation in this new system of distributing registration information.
