

# V2C FLAG Design Contest

*WINNING flag design will be flown in Waterville, Ohio*

## **OFFICAL WATERVILLE V2C FLAG DESIGN CONTEST RULES**

### Purpose of Flag Contest:

--Waterville has grown from a village to a city, effective 2011. The design of the new city flag should reflect the city of Waterville: yesterday-today-tomorrow.

### Eligibility

--Contest is open to legal citizen children grades Kindergarten -12.

### Flag Design Submission

--Provide flag design in color on 8.5x11 (letter size) paper in landscape or horizontal layout on the front side of the sheet. Place your name, address, phone number and email address on the reverse side.

--Include a second 8.5 x 11 (letter-size) page with a rationale for the design using 200 words or less, on the front side of the sheet. DO NOT staple or paperclip to the flag design sheet. Place your name, address, phone number on the reverse side.

### --Suggestions:

- \* Keep design simple (i.e. Limiting colors to two or three). Cost of manufacturing the flag will be considered in judges' decision.
- \* Use meaningful symbolism. The flag's image(s), color or patterns should relate to what it symbolizes and the history of Waterville.
- \* All elements of the flag design must be original and created by the entrant. No "stock", "clip art" or royalty free art or copyrighted elements can be used.
- \* All submitted designs become the property of the Waterville V2C committee to fit flag manufacturing requirements.
- \* By submitting a design, the entrant agrees to be bound by the contest rules.
- \* Mail entries flat in a 9x 12 envelope to V2C contest, c/o Waterville Area Chamber of Commerce, PO Box 74, Waterville, OH 43566-0074. All entries must be postmarked by February 21, 2012 and received by February 25, 2012. Entries that do not follow submission requirements and any lost, late, mutilated or unreadable entries will not be accepted into contest.

### Judging

--Judges will be named by the Waterville V2C Committee.

--If no suitable entry is submitted, the existing Waterville flag design may be modified at the discretion of the V2C committee and the City of Waterville.

--The decision of the judges is final and will be announced in the first quarter of 2012 via various media outlets. To receive a copy of the decision, send a #10 self-addressed stamped envelope to: V2C Flag Design Result, c/o Waterville Area Chamber of Commerce, PO Box 74, Waterville, OH 43566-0074.
